LINDENTHORPE PARK – The Improvements Now Being Made at this Beautiful Resort

This beautiful place situated in a grove of old shade tree on the Delaware River, at Marcus Hook, is now undergoing extensive improvements, and in conjunction with the Silverthorne, the adjoining property, will be used as a park. The buildings are being thoroughly overhauled and painted, the grounds beautified, and a handsome fence will surround the whole property, comprising twelve acres in all. The park will have 1100 feet river front, and a new wharf is now being constructed directly in front of the old mansion.

The trolley company now runs its cars within a short distance and will commence work in a few days laying its tracks along the river, and will carry passengers directly
