UPLAND'S NEW HALL IS WELL UNDER WAY – Building at Home for Athletic Association Being Rushed – Borough Jottings of Interest

Work on the new Upland Athletic Association's hall is being pushed as rapidly as possible at the present time to make up for the delay caused by the finding of much rock when the work of excavating was in progress. Bricklayers are getting their portion of the work well under way, and yesterday the heavy iron girders which will support the main floor were placed in position. A few weeks more will see the building in such shape that an idea of its finished appearance will be possible even to those residents who have not seen the plans. It is not probable that it will be completed ready for occupancy before the opening of Winter, although it may be possible to have a basketball team before the end of the season.
